- Pātai atu – He aha te mea tino pai o tō rātou rangi?

- Me pānui tahi – Me pānui tahi me āu tamariki.
- Kōrerotia – Kia kaha te kōrero tahi me ngā kaiako mō te ako a āu tamariki.

Kei te akiaki mātou i a koe ki te kōrerorero tahi me ngā kaiako mō te ako a tāu tamaiti. Ka tino pai ake ngā māka a ngā tamariki mehemea ka mahi ngātahi te whānau me te kura.

- Me kōrero tahi - Talk with your children every day.
- Āta whakarongo - Listen to what they have to say.
- Pātai atu – What was the highlight of their day?
- Āwhina - Help your children with their learning.
- Me pānui tahi – Read with your children.
- Kōrerotia - Talk regularly with the kaiako about your child's learning.

We encourage you to discuss your child's learning with their kaiako. All our tamariki will achieve better results with kura and whānau working together.
