

TE WHAKAMAHI I NGĀ PAEREWA PAETAE (Taumata 1)

Working with the aligned standards Māori medium: NCEA LEVEL 1

A new set of NCEA Level 1 standards are available for use in Māori-medium settings. These new standards are aligned to Level 6 of Te Marautanga o Aotearoa and are available for all learning areas. They are often referred to as 'the aligned standards'.

This year, 2014, teachers have a choice of which standards to use in their Level 6 programmes (the new 'aligned' standards, or the existing standards).

From 2015, this choice will not be available. All Māori-medium kura teaching programmes that lead to NCEA 1 will be required to use the aligned standards. The existing standards will expire.

This is a Ministry of Education professional learning and development initiative.

This course is a comprehensive 5 day workshop being offered in three locations. The course consists of two hui (a 2-day hui in May + a 3-day hui in June/July). Participants are expected to attend all five days of the course.

TARGET AUDIENCE: Kaiako using Te Marautanga o Aotearoa to teach programmes leading to NCEA

Level 1.

COURSE DURATION: Two hui—5 days in total (Hui 1=2 days + Hui 2= 3 days).

COURSE LOCATION: Three locations: Auckland, Wellington, + one other location (possibly Rotorua).

The third location will be confirmed based on where participants are located.

COURSE COSTS: Nil. All course costs, including travel and accommodation will be covered. Private car costs for attending hui will be reimbursed directly to participating teachers on receipt of a disbursement



claim form. Reimbursement is paid only for travel over 60 kilometres round trip and at 40 cents per kilometre (with the first 60 kms deducted from the total travelled). Where possible, car-pooling is expected, or, if more economical, rental cars will be booked and paid for by Haemata Ltd.

TRDs

Teacher Relief Day payments will be made to the kura of participating kaiako at the following rates:

Hui 1: 1 TRD @ \$250/day inc GST Hui 2: 2 TRDs @ \$250/day inc GST.

FACILITATORS: Hineihaea Murphy, Āwhina Gray, Beth Dixon, NZQA moderators, Ministry of Education facilitators, panel leaders, and specialist standards writers.

PARTICIPANTS' KURA WILL AGREE TO

- Release the teacher(s) from school to attend workshops if held during school time
- Provide TRDs not funded for (if necessary)
- Cover any daily allowances or other entitlements that may be payable under the terms and conditions of a participating teacher's employment agreement.

- Teachers enrolling for a course must be committed to attend all workshops in that course.
- Spaces are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Don't be disappointed submit an enrolment as soon as possible.
