Collected naturally, through
EVERY DAY interactions
MAKE: In order to plan
learning, kaiako form
INITIAL judgements from
evidence gathered over time
and use the alignment table
to determine where ākonga
are currently.

moderated & confirmed
TWICE annually

MODERATE:
To ensure that an OTJ
is **robust, reliable and
valid, consistent and
accurate, kaiako come
together as a group and
cross check the initial
OTJ to validate sources.**

FINALISE:
Confirm the OTJ
and enter it into
TWA. This data
informs next
steps for ākonga
and whānau
management.
