WHAT IS A SCHOOL SNAPSHOT?

It is a narrative co-authored by you or a group and the project coordinator.

The kura sets the topic, identifies those to be involved and a timeframe for completion with the coordinator. This may be 1, 2 or a group of people. On average a total of 2-3 hours work.

It is about 1-2 pages long and very concise. We invite you to include some visuals e.g. photographs to illustrate your journey.
